All answers should be checked yes to be eligible for the AMP. If all criteria have been met, then student will need to find a core EEB faculty member to agree to be their master advisor.

Once admitted to AMP, student may take up to 12 units of graduate coursework which may apply toward both Bachelor's and Master's degrees. Student will be charged tuition at the undergraduate rate and retain eligibility for undergraduate scholarships.

Should a student complete more than 12 units of graduate coursework prior to the BS degree being awarded, the student will change from undergraduate student status to graduate student status. Once in graduate student status, the student will be charged tuition at the graduate rate and will not be eligible for any financial aid or scholarships for undergraduate students.
